We look forward to helping you continue your education in the field of E.M.S. This document is to help you understand this department and give you a general view of what is expected of you. In return we will do all that we can to give you the experiences that you need to graduate and prepare you to write your exams. We are also willing to provide time for scenarios and to practice your skills. Your Preceptor is your first person to inquire about extra help.

Because of our schedule you will be working with a number of practitioners and will be paired with several day to day preceptors. You will be expected to work with paramedics, EMTs and EMRs and are expected to treat all with respect and courtesy. You will be provided with cleaning supplies and a room which is furnished with a bed, desk and chair. You will be expected to keep it clean. A full kitchen is available for your use. This kitchen has all cooking utensils as well as eating utensils. The two washrooms each have a shower and a single washer and dryer are available for you as well.

You will need to bring your own food, bedding (blankets, pillows and sheets for a single bed), toiletries and towel. There are grocery stores here in town if you wish to buy your food here. Your practicum will begin on Monday morning with an interview with a representative of / or the coordinator of Cardston County Emergency Services.
